Sawmill Canyon (Frisco) Quarterly Report for Q2 2021

Q2 2021 Summary of Activities

Kennecott Exploration (KEX) has completed a UAV (un-crewed aerial vehicle) magnetics and orthophoto survey over portions of the property. A few days of geologic field work were conducted to review recently identified targets of interest. The field review, along with the preliminary magnetics data, has generated several proposed drill targets that are currently being considered for further archaeological survey and permitting.

Drilling

Drilling activities remain postponed until further notice.

Geology




Figure 1. Plan map showing the location of surface samples collected in Q2 2021.

The team reviewed two areas of interest over four days of field work, including a high mag feature just south-southwest of the Cactus Breccia and a resistivity low (conductive) anomaly between Accrington and Reciprocity. A total of 20 samples were collected and sent for assay. Geochemistry is available in Despatch EB80001498 (ALS Chemex Labjob EL21117619; Figure 1).

Permitting

No new permitting activities have commenced; however, the team is considering additional cultural surveys and an amendment to include 5-10 new drill sites and associated trails where needed.

Health, Safety, Environment, and Communities

Nothing to report.

Geophysics




Figure 2. Plan map of originally proposed and final UAV magnetics survey boundaries.

UAV based magnetics and orthophoto surveys were completed in Q2 2021. These surveys covered the majority of Sawmill Canyon in greater detail than previous aerial surveys for the property. A total of 21.5 km² were flown for magnetics at 25m line spacing (see Figure 2) and 30.8 km² for the orthophotos. Results clearly define existing targets areas with known magnetic signatures and have highlighted areas of interest for further follow-up (which may include field mapping, surface and/or soil sampling, and/or drilling in the future).

Other Activities

Nothing to report.

Expenditure

Tables 1 and 2 include a summary of expenditures for Q2 2021. Significant costs during Q2 included the UAV magnetics and orthophotos surveys completed by MWH (Drilling and Contracted Labour), staff costs for individuals supporting the geophysical work, and some limited field work. There were a few credits to the project code during Q2 including refund for unused drilling muds (Drilling Support) and corrections related to staff cost allocation (i.e. reallocation of staff to other codes for time not directly tied to the support of Sawmill Canyon field activities). Field Support and Misc. costs included food, fuel, and accommodations for individuals supporting on site activities. The additional spend in Q2 2021, brings the total all-in expenditure to \$4,509,425.
